



COMMUNITY INVESTMENT GRANTS

UWNCNM collaborates with other nonprofits and community partners to focus and align our community around strategies designed to improve family stability and educational attainment. Part of that response is accomplished by Community Investment grant-making.

In July 2022, UWNCNM granted more than

\$2 million to 57 organizations

that work to improve life for children, youth, and families in Bernalillo, Sandoval, Torrance and Valencia counties. In addition, \$400,000 was granted to 20 organization in Santa Fe County (thanks in part to a gift from MacKenzie Scott).

The Community Investment Fund grant categories are:

- 1) **Impact Grants** focus on education/youth development and family stability.
- 2) Community Resilience/Basic Needs Grants support needs such as food and shelter.
- 3) Capacity Building Grants improve a nonprofit's ability to fulfill its mission.
