UWNCNM, including the Community Impact Fund, annual grant funding to health and human service programs in Bernalillo, Sandoval, Torrance, Valencia and Santa Fe counties with a focus on Family Stability and Education/Youth Development. Basic Needs grants support emergent needs, such as food, utility and rental assistance, emergency shelter services, etc.

Tax Help NM offers free tax preparation services to New Mexico households with an annual income of \$65,000 or less as well as senior citizens. Tax Help NM offers in-person tax preparation, processing of tax returns through intake sites, and a virtual tax preparation hub.

The Family Advocacy Center (FAC) provides free and confidential services for victims of interpersonal violence. The FAC has trauma-trained nurses on-site, legal aid counselors, and police officers available to assist individuals in all the ways they may need help.

211 is an information and referral helpline that connects callers to resources to help meet their basic needs. The 211 helpline serves the five-county area United Way of Central New Mexico serves, as well as Catron, Cibola, McKinley, and Socorro counties. Rising Together (formerly Mission: Families and Mission: Graduate) helps children and families by connecting them to the services they need, and by helping to increase school engagement and attendance, support early literacy, promote career exploration and more.
