

The **Family Advocacy Center** (FAC) supports victims of sexual assault and interpersonal violence. Services are located in the same building, which reduces additional trauma and stress for clients. Partner services include advocacy, medical care, legal and financial assistance, law enforcement and prosecution.

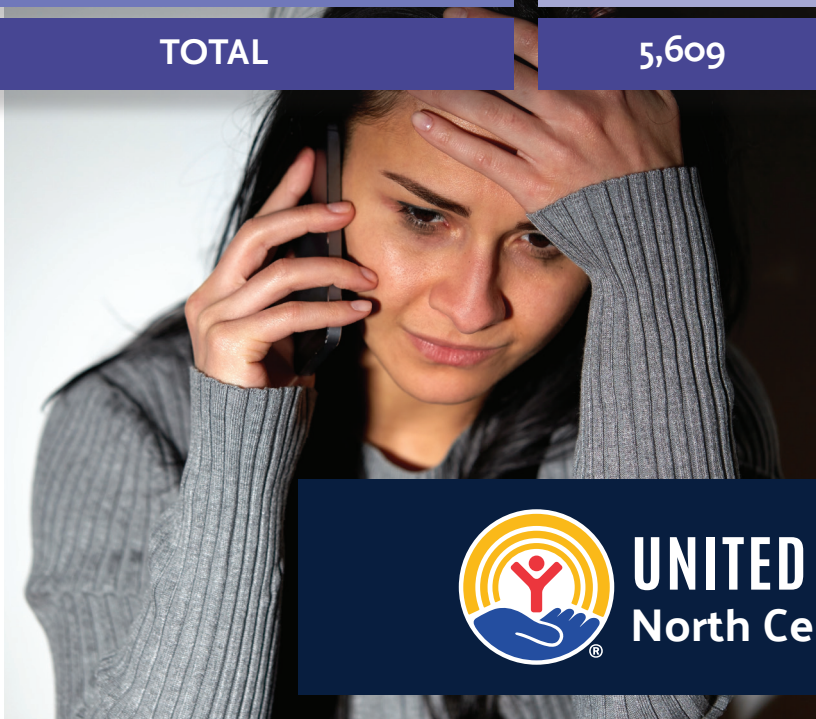
Nationally, one in three women and one in seven men are victims of some form of domestic violence, which means that in the Albuquerque metro area, approximately 80,000 women and 30,000 men are victims of domestic violence each year.

More than 5,000 people seek services at FAC annually. Victims need a wide array of supports, like shelter, food and clothing, physical safety, physical and mental health attention, advocacy and legal support, and ultimately opportunities for sustainable, positive change. FAC mitigates the effects of domestic violence and strengthens the path to resiliency.
