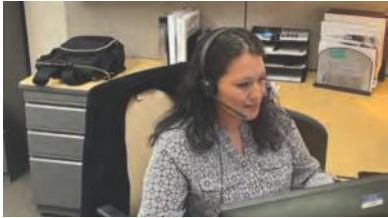

GRANTS: Supporting Local Programs

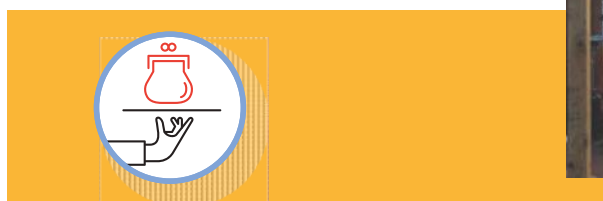
We build strong partnerships with our nonprofit grantees to ensure our giving is strategic and impactful, aligning with community needs through Trust-Based Philanthropy practices.

- Impact grants focus on education/youth development and family stability.
- Basic Needs grants support emergent needs, such as food and emergency shelter.
- Capacity Building grants aim to improve a nonprofit's ability to fulfill its mission.
- Donor Group grants are awarded to agencies that align with the focus area of each donor group.
- Multi-year grants provide ongoing support, allowing organizations to focus on their essential work without funding restrictions.
- Rural-County grants fund rural areas that don't often have access to charitable dollars.
